0939 numbers are opt-in: The customer has to advise his carrier to make this numbering range available for him.

Advertising Rules

(for information only, please check the Austrian regulator's website for latest and complete information: www.rtr.at)

1. The content provider has to make sure that all advertising contains the following information in an easily readable way:
 - a) the number to call the service;
 - b) information regarding the price for using the service
 - c) a short description of the service
 - d) eventual limitations of the service
2. The price information has (for pay-per-minute numbers) to be in "Euro per Minute" (€/min.). Is possible, the expected price for the complete consumption of the service have to be mentioned, too. (i.e. for viewing a movie with a voice dialer you can tell the total price for the connection for the movie's length.)
3. The pricing information has (for pay-per-call number) to be in "Euro per Call" (€/Anruf).
4. Written information has to be easily readable and should be near the number advertised. Audible information has to be immediately after announcing the number and must be clearly understandable.

Announcements

The carrier makes sure that an announcement stating the price per minute or call is being played at the beginning of the connection.



Time limits

The duration of pay-per-minute connections is limited to 30 minutes (60 minutes, if tariff lower than 2,20 €)

Opt-In for Dialers

Carrier are forced by law to make sure that a 0939 number, the only number legally usable for dialers, is only reachable from customers which actively have asked for activating this numbering range.
